

Staying Safe Around Bats



Bats can spread rabies, a fatal disease.



Any bat that is found on the ground, or that has been caught by a pet or child, should be considered as **potentially rabid** until proven otherwise by laboratory tests.

Bats may be unrecognizable when fallen on the ground with wings folded inward.

Do NOT touch bats!



Educate kids to not touch bats, nor wild animals, and to let an adult know if they find one.

- 1) Keep people away from the animal.
- 2) Capture the bat without touching it. Use a jar, box, or other sturdy container.
